



Post Operation Instructions: Biopsy, Lacerations, Warts & Minor Surgery

- Keep the surgical site clean. You may remove the dressing tomorrow. Wash the area with mild soap and warm water. Pat dry and apply topical antibiotic (bacitracin, Neosporin, triple antibiotic) and dry sterile dressing.
- Change the dressing daily or more frequently if there is a lot of drainage.
- If the area is becoming more red, painful, or oozing creamy pus within two to three days after the procedure, please call the office.
- If you were given a prescription take as directed.
- Following wart surgery it is not unusual to have bleeding at the site within the first 24 hours.
- Change the dressing as needed
- Do not soak unless you were instructed to do so.
- If you have stitches, avoid baths, until they are removed. Showering is fine.
- Wash the site with soap after showering.
